THE NIGHTMARE LEAGUE No. 8/2008 - Aug 16

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1. Introduction

As many as four managers failed to submit orders this week. One of them has now received a warning.

The top teams in Premier League had a good round, so Chicago Licks remain four points ahead of Walhalla FC, who in turn have increased the gap to third placed DFK Mål from one to two points. Game PC follow fourth as before, but are now four ponts behind DFK Mål and unlikely to join the medal fight. The relegation fight consists of the remaining eight teams. Übermenschen have dropped to the bottom place, and are one point behind Rangers and Illuminatus! The remaining five teams are on 14 points, one point above the relegation zone.

Botanica have got a two point advantage over A.K.A. in League Championship after winning their match. Nightmare Heros have advanced to third place, a further two points behind A.K.A. New Frøya have fallen to fourth place, and are one point behind Nightmare Heros together with Currents of Space. Madmartigan C and Gamblers Utd collected some points this round, but are still too far from safe ground to have much chance to avoid relegation. Rejected F.C have fallen into the relegation zone, and are two points behind FSV Mainz who hold the last place above the line.

The two top teams in League One lost both their matches, allowing The Renaissance to jump straight to the top. Queen and Serial Killers are only one point behind and still in the promotion zone, but Enga are now only behind them on goal difference. Jirs Park Rangers and Furinkan HS follow only one point behind, meaning that half the teams now have a realistic chance of gaining promotion. Symington tinto doubled their goal tally, but with only six points in total are probably bound for relegation anyway. Texas Hold'em U are four points ahead of Symington, while Ormen and Foundation are six points ahead, Foundation outside the relegation zone on better goal difference.

The three top teams in League Two keep full steam ahead so there are no changes amongst them, they are just increasing the gap to the teams chasing behind. Populistene are now four points away from the promotion zone, so it seems that Valiant City, Chicken Run and Lower Saxony will take the first three places. Lyn got their second point of the season, and are now only two points behind Blue Hearts. As Blue Hearts also managed to trash their goal difference to such an extent that it is weaker than Lyn's, this means that if Lyn win the match between these two teams in the next round then Blue Hearts will suddenly be at the bottom.

DFK Mål defended their status as the luckiest team in the Nightmare League. Valiant City climb past American Natives to claim second place. Monarkia have overtaken Ajax Aswandam as the unluckiest team this season, with Serial Killers being new in the top three.

The home advantage is still 8 VP. Round 17 and 18 will be played, and so will the cup semifinals.

The deadline for next round is Friday, 26 September, at 1700 hrs CET as usual.

Scorers: Gamblers Utd keep hope alive by coming back after having been 0-1 down and secure a narrow, but deserved win. They were probably helped by Patrik Prekopp's absence, but being present is part of the game. Prekopp is balancing on a thin line, with Mainz being very much involved in the relegation fight now. Ajax Aswandam - Directors 5:1 Hosni Badawi (12., 24.), Rizq Shehata (1., 58.), Earth Scorers: Song (38.) ***Frank Capra (46.) Ajax Aswandam lost 4 VP in attack due to the 3:1-rule and used most of the players out of position, but were still far superior against rather pathetic Directors. With this, AA are suddenly far away from the relegation struggle. 1:2 A.K.A. - Botanica Scorers: Billy Batson (79.) ***Bellis Perennis (60.), Fragmites (78.)The top match of the round took place in the absence of Botanica-manager Jerry Struik. But both teams created lots of chances, and it was a minor miracle that it was still 0-0 at half time. The fun continued after the break and A.K.A. seemed like the strongest team until sudenly Botanica scored - twice! A.K.A. tried to come back, but only managed to score once, giving Botanica a definitive advantage in the fight for winning the League Championship. But kudos to both team for making it a very good match! They were rather lucky to win this match, as Rejected F.C were the better team and created more chances, so it is quite amazing they managed to win 5-2 in the end. My guess, however, is that this result goes a long way towards ensuring that both teams go down in the end and not just Mad City...
